

**IMPORTANT – READ CAREFULLY BEFORE OPENING THE SEALED PACKAGE WHICH CONTAINS THIS DATABASE:** This License Agreement is a legal agreement between you, the Licensee (either an individual or an entity), and American Statistical Association and Institute of Mathematical Statistics, the Licensors, governing your use of the CIS/ED Database on the CD-ROM you acquired from Licensors. By opening the sealed packaging, copying or otherwise using the Database, Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms of this Agreement. If Licensee does not agree to the terms of this Agreement, Licensors are unwilling to license the Database to the Licensee. In such an event, Licensee may not use or copy the Database, and Licensee should promptly contact Licensors for instructions on returning it. This License Agreement is separate from and shall not be considered a part of any license for the CIS/ED Database that may be purchased and accessed on Licensors' website.

Licensors provide the Database and User Manual contained in the package and any modifications, updates, revisions or enhancements received by you from Licensors, and license its use within the terms stated below:

Licensee is granted a nonexclusive, nontransferable and perpetual license to use the Database contained on the CD-ROM under the terms stated in this Agreement for use authorized by the Level of License purchased according to the Current Index to Statistics Order Form. All title and copyrights in and to the Database, the User Guide, and any copies of the Database, are owned by Licensors. Licensee is granted the right to copy and distribute the User Guide to authorized users of the Database. Licensors reserve all other rights. Licensee may not make copies, translations or modifications of or to the Database, except Licensee may copy the Database into machine-readable form in support of Licensees' use of the Database. Licensee must reproduce the copyright notice on any copy of the Database or portion of the Database merged into another database or computer program. All copies of the Database and any portion of the Database merged into or used in conjunction with another database or computer program will continue to be the property of Licensors and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Licensee may not assign, sell, distribute, lease, rent, sublicense or transfer the Database or this Agreement or disclose the Database to any other person not authorized to use it under the applicable License Level. Licensee agrees to take reasonable and necessary steps to prevent violations of the terms of the agreement by their users, including suspension of access privileges for known violators. Licensors may terminate this Agreement if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement. In such event, Licensee must promptly return the Database to Licensors or at Licensors' discretion, destroy the Database, together with all copies, modifications and merged portions in any form, including any copy in your computer memory or on a hard disk.

Level of Licenses: **COMMERCIAL LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use on an unlimited number of computers at a single corporate site and by current employees of the corporate Licensee who hold valid passwords for access to the corporate computer system or network. Licensee agrees to restrict access to the Database only to authorized employee users and to prevent access by persons no longer employed by the Licensee. The Database may be accessed from, but not transferred, in whole or in part, outside the single corporate site. **GENERAL LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use at a single contiguous location and may be installed on individual computers and/or on a network for on-site use only. Licensee agrees to restrict access to the Database only to authorized users, to prevent access by persons no longer affiliated with the Licensee, and to prevent remote access to the Database. **UNIVERSITY LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use by faculty, staff, students, and visitors authorized to conduct research at an institution of higher education only and holding valid passwords to access the computer system or network at a single campus of the educational institution.
